Sports:

We offer a wide variety of opportunities for athletic competition. The St. Luke's Redhaweaks compete in the **Bay Area Lutheran League**, an association of seven WELS schools. We field teams in *co-ed soccer, boys and girls cross country, girls and boys basketball, cheerleading, co-ed volleyball, boys and girls track and field, and co-ed softball*. Team coaches are parent volunteers. **Principal Lange** serves as our *Athletic Director*.

Outdoor Education Opportunities:

Each year we take an assortment of field trips as they are available in each classroom. The 5th and 6th grades spend three days each fall at **Camp Timbers**, the YMCA camp in West Branch, MI. Our area WELS schools gather for three days of education and fun. Every other year the 7th and 8th grades travel to Wolverine, MI, for a **week long winter excursion**. Again, the area WELS schools cooperate for a memorable educational adventure.
